POSITION: Hound Around Town

SPECIAL CONDITIONS: Minimum 6 hours of availability per month. Availability is

flexible and can be paired with another volunteer position.

REPORTS TO: Volunteer Coordinator and Manager

CUSTOMER SERVICE EXPECTATION:

Every volunteer action performed impacts customer satisfaction, and this has a direct impact on the success of the Society. Providing excellent customer service to both internal and external customers is considered a critical part of being a volunteer.

FUNCTION:

Pet Alliance of Greater Orlando's **Hound Around Town** program is a unique opportunity to enrich the life of a shelter dog by taking them out of the shelter and into the community. Not only is it a nice day out for **you**, but our shelter dogs will be **furever** grateful for the chance to relax out of the shelter environment, sniff all **Pet Alliance** approved sights, and get exposure to adopters.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Take dogs out 2 hours or so at a time to any dog friendly location. NO DOG PARKS OR OFFLEASH AREAS.
- 2. Make sure you have a water bottle, treats, poop bags, and the dog is on a weiss walkie
- 3. Must be able to handle dogs on a leash (do not have to be a bark buddy to participate, volunteers and staff can assist you getting the dog out of the kennel).
- 4. Pick up times are 9am 3pm daily
- 5. Dogs must be back by 5pm
- 6. Post to social media/send pictures to volunteer staff
 - Use #houndaroundtown

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Minimum age of 18
- Volunteers 13-17 years old can get hours and accompany their parent/guardian
- Parent/Guardian must hold the leash at all times

- Attend open house
- Must watch Hound Around Town Video
- Ability to communicate with a variety of people effectively and without judgement or making negative remarks
- Must have reliable transportation
- Must be available via phone at all times

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITY:

- Highly motivated toward the welfare and humane treatment of all animals
- High level reading, writing, spelling and communication skills in English
- Ability to communicate effectively with the public and staff
- Agreement to support Pet Alliance of Greater Orlando policies and procedures

PHYSICAL AND MENTAL DEMANDS:

- Safely handling small to extra-large dogs in a shelter requires average vision, hearing, steadiness of hands/body, quick reflexes, physical strength and mental alertness.
- The physical demands of this position also require standing, walking and bending for extended periods of times. Lifting requirements of up to 50 pounds

WORKING CONDITIONS:

- This position will involve working offsite in the community, but also being at the shelter in the dog kennels.
- This position requires moving between rooms and buildings that may result in increased exposure to extremes in temperature.
- Position requires frequent and routine public contact as well as the ability to multi-task
 and maintain safe animal handling techniques under conditions that can be fast paced (if
 the dog is taken to a public place)
