

PET ALLIANCE VOLUNTEER POSITION DESCRIPTION

POSITION: Cat Condo Volunteer

SPECIAL CONDITIONS: Minimum 6 hours of availability per month. Regular

interactions with cats is required.

REPORTS TO: Volunteer Coordinator and Offsite Coordinator

CUSTOMER SERVICE EXPECTATION:

Every volunteer action performed impacts customer satisfaction, and this has a direct impact on the success of the organization. Providing excellent customer service to both internal and external customers is considered a critical part of being a volunteer.

FUNCTION:

The Cat Condo Volunteer takes care of cats in our offsite locations with special attention paid to the locations at PetSmart Lake Mary, PetSmart Altamonte, and PetSmart Ocoee.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Clean cages, provide food and water, and clean bedding/toys
- Provide enrichment to cats in care
- Tidy (sweep, sanitize, etc.) cattery areas
- · Restock items such as litter and food
- Report inventory of care items to offsite coordinators
- Socialize and spend time with cats in care
- Interact with potential adopters, and answer questions about the animals with the information provided in their offsite packets.
- Assist with the adoption process
- Keep track of cats that got adopted
- Communicate any medical needs as noticed
- Bring donations or adoption agreements back to the shelters as needed

TRAINING:

- Must complete an application for all parties volunteering (parents and under 16 volunteer teams must both submit applications)
- · Must complete a video orientation training, and a quiz following the video
- Must attend an interactive (hands on training) at one of the locations



QUALIFICATIONS:

 Position is open to anyone age 13 and up with a parent or guardian who is over the age of 18, or any person who is over the age of 16.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITY:

- Highly motivated toward the welfare and humane treatment of all animals
- High level reading, writing, spelling and communication skills in English
- Ability to communicate effectively with the public and staff
- Agreement to support Pet Alliance policies and procedures

PHYSICAL AND MENTAL DEMANDS:

- Safely handling cats in this position requires average vision, hearing, steadiness of hands/body, quick reflexes and mental alertness
- The physical demands of this position also require standing, walking and bending for extended periods of times. Lifting requirements of up to 25 pounds

WORKING CONDITIONS:

- Most work is performed in a retail store environment
- This position requires moving between rooms and buildings that may result in increased exposure to extremes in temperature
- Position requires frequent and routine public contact as well as the ability to multi-task and maintain safe animal handling techniques under conditions that can be fast paced
