What You'll Do:

- 🐾 Monitor health and behavior, reporting concerns to Foster Coordinators
- 🐾 Transport foster animals to and from the shelter for check-ups and vaccines

When & Where?

- 📍 Your own home!
- 🕒 Must foster at least 1 animal per year to stay active

What You Need to Know:

- ✓ Minimum age: 13 (with active parental participation).
- ✓ If under 18, a parent/guardian must attend orientation and handle animal appointments and transport.
- ✓ Students are eligible for community service hours
