JOB SUMMARY

As a **Bark Buddy**, you'll play a vital role in making sure our shelter dogs get the love, care, and exercise they need! You'll help socialize them, assist adopters in finding the right pet, and keep the shelter environment clean and welcoming.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Caring for Dogs:

- Clean up after dogs (kennels, walks, yards)
- Provide fresh water at all times
- Help track exercise, medical, and behavior notes
- Bathe dogs, when needed

During Non-Operating Hours (9 AM - 12 PM):

- · Exercise and play with dogs
- Provide enrichment, socialization & basic training

During Operating Hours (12 PM - 6 PM):

- Greet adopters & guide them to suitable dogs
- Socialize & exercise dogs between customer visits

Other Ways to Help:

- Keep work areas clean, including the Volunteer Den
- Assist with shelter events
- Take on additional tasks as needed

HOUND AROUND TOWN PROGRAM:

- Take approved dogs on off-site trips for socialization & exercise
- Observe behaviors & provide a feedback report

QUALIFICATIONS

- 18 years or older
- Dog handling experience preferred but not required
- Good communication & customer service skills
- Ability to follow Pet Alliance policies & procedures
- Must be comfortable communicating in English to ensure clear interactions with staff, visitors, and fellow volunteers, Bilingual volunteers are welcome

PHYSICAL AND MENTAL DEMANDS

- Ability to stand, walk & bend for extended periods
- Comfortable lifting, pushing, and pulling up to 50 lbs
- Good vision, hearing, quick reflexes and decision making to handle dogs safely

WORK ENVIRONMENT

- Work takes place in a noisy shelter setting (can be extremely hot in summer)
- Moving between rooms/buildings may expose you to temperature and humidity changes



• Regular interaction with the public & multi-tasking in a fast-paced setting
