JOB SUMMARY

As a Kitty Cuddler, you'll play a vital role in ensuring our shelter cats receive the socialization, care, and enrichment they need! You'll help provide a clean and welcoming environment, assist adopters in finding the right pet, and support the well-being of our feline residents.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Caring for Cats:

- Clean up after cats (cages, cattery, surrounding areas)
- Provide fresh water at all times
- Help track socialization, medical, and behavior notes
- Assist staff with daily cat care needs

During Non-Operating Hours (9 AM - 12 PM):

- Socialize and provide enrichment to cats
- Help with laundry and start new loads
- Assist staff in cleaning and organizing the cattery

During Operating Hours (12 PM - 6 PM):

- Greet adopters and guide them to suitable cats
- Socialize and interact with cats between customer visits

Other Ways to Help:

- Keep work areas clean, including the Volunteer Den
- Assist with shelter events
- Take on additional tasks as needed

QUALIFICATIONS

- 18 years or older
- Cat care experience preferred but not required
- Good communication & customer service skills
- Ability to follow Pet Alliance policies & procedures
- Must be comfortable communicating in English to ensure clear interactions with staff, visitors, and fellow volunteers, Bilingual volunteers are welcome

PHYSICAL AND MENTAL DEMANDS

- Ability to stand, walk & bend for extended periods
- Comfortable lifting, pushing, and pulling up to 25 lbs
- Good vision, hearing, quick reflexes and decision making skills for safe cat handling

WORK ENVIRONMENT

- Work takes place in a noisy shelter setting
- Moving between rooms/buildings may expose you to temperature and humidity changes
- Regular interaction with the public & multi-tasking in a fast-paced setting
