As a **Youth Volunteer**, you'll be a vital part of the shelter's daily operations, helping to create a safe, clean, and welcoming environment for both animals and visitors. From hands-on animal care to customer service and facility upkeep, your contributions will directly impact the well-being of shelter pets and the experience of potential adopters. This role offers a unique opportunity to gain real-world experience in animal welfare, teamwork, and responsibility—all while making a difference in the lives of animals in need.

## RESPONSIBILITIES

Caring for Animals:

- Help create enrichment activities for shelter pets
- Help with puppy and kitten socialization
- Assist with laundry and donations
- Participate in shadowing opportunities to learn about other areas of the shelter

During Non-Operating Hours (9 AM - 12 PM):

- Assist animal care staff with kennel and cattery cleaning, diet preparation, feeding, lobby cleaning, and kitchen duties
- Set up play yards for shelter dogs

### During Operating Hours (12 PM - 6 PM):

- Greet potential adopters, guide them to adoptable animals, and assist staff with adoptionrelated questions
- Scoop dog kennels and spot clean cat kennels
- Clean and sanitize dog play yards

### Other Ways to Help:

- Keep work areas clean and organized, including the Volunteer Den
- Assist with shelter events
- Take on additional tasks as needed

### QUALIFICATIONS

- Ages 16-17
- Animal handling experience preferred, but not required
- Good communication & customer service skills
- Ability to work independently and complete assigned tasks
- Ability to follow Pet Alliance policies & procedures
- Must be comfortable communicating in English to ensure clear interactions with staff, visitors, and fellow volunteers, Bilingual volunteers are welcome

### PHYSICAL AND MENTAL DEMANDS

- Ability to stand, walk & bend for extended periods
- Comfortable lifting, pushing, and pulling up to 25 lbs
- Good vision, hearing, steadiness, quick reflexes and mental alertness skills for safe handling of animals



#### WORK ENVIRONMENT

- Work takes place in a noisy shelter setting (can be extremely hot in summer)
- Moving between rooms/buildings may expose you to temperature and humidity changes
- Regular interaction with the public & multi-tasking in a fast-paced setting
